A.W.A.'s WARNING

(Australian Workplace Agreements)

It has come to our attention that some of our members who are parties to the MGAV Certified Agreement 2002 have concluded Australian Workplace Agreements with individual employees.

We are concerned that such members may inadvertently breach the provisions of the certified agreement and expose their businesses to possible prosecution and substantial penalties. A certified agreement predating the AWA prevails over it to the extent of any inconsistency, unless such agreement expressly provides for an AWA to override it.
