Master Grocers' CEO Appointed for a Third Term to Small Business Advisory Council

Victoria's small businesses will have greater access to senior levels of Government under the newly appointed Small Business Advisory Council, the Minister for Small Business, André Haermeyer, announced in December.

"The new 25 member Council is comprised overwhelmingly of Victorian business owner/operators and gives them direct input to developing policies, including the Bracks Government's Small Business Statement," Mr Haermeyer said.
